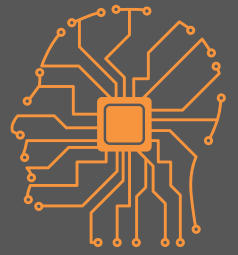


BUILDING BETTER JUDGEMENT IN THE AGE OF AI



1 BE DELIBERATE ABOUT WHERE AI STOPS

Use AI to inform thinking, not make decisions. Ask: What's your reasoning? What did you consider? What did you rule out?



2 CREATE SPACE FOR REAL DECISION-MAKING

Use real-world scenarios. Encourage debate, challenge, and shared perspectives.



3 MEASURE BEHAVIOUR, NOT PARTICIPATION

Look for improved decision confidence, reasoning quality, and faster resolution.



4 USE AI AS A CHALLENGER, NOT A CRUTCH

Normalise challenge, reward reasoning, and ensure leaders model good thinking.



5 BUILD A CULTURE WHERE THINKING IS VISIBLE

Compare AI outputs with human judgement. Encourage questioning and adaptation.
